Introduction

This information pack has been prepared to inform you of important dates, registration information and commitments regarding the 2024 National Carnival to be held in Fremantle.

The Fremantle Carnival will be held from Sunday 29th of September to Saturday 5th October 2024.

There are important dates and information in this pack that you need to be aware of.

Worklocker is our official supplier for all apparel required to participate in the National Carnival.

Some items are compulsory and other items are optional.

The compulsory players kit will consist of the State jumper, playing shorts, red socks, State red polo top (new design) and state navy casual shorts. (the previous black state casual shorts can be used).

Optional merchandise will be the training/warm up top, navy hoodie, navy full length zip hoodie, navy state cap (new design) and navy soft shell jacket.



Carnival Registration and Timetable

As per previous carnivals, priority registration will be given to the players who attended last year's National Carnival in Maroochydore, but registration and payment of the deposit on PlayHQ are required to confirm your place in the relevant team.

It is AFL Masters SA goal to enter as many teams as possible in the below age groups,

Selection process for teams:

- There will be 24 players maximum per team.
- Preference for Women's players will be given to those that have played a minimum of 2 Women's Masters games during the current season.
- Players will be placed in the appropriate team based on their age. However, coaches may
 negotiate with other coaches to have a player change teams but players are only allowed to
 play down in age groups.
- Players are considered registered for a team once the player has registered on PlayHQ and full payment has been received (not one or the other)
- Regarding age groups, a player who turns the required age by the end of December in the year
 of the Carnival, may be eligible to play in that age group.
- No dispensations will be given for players to play up in older age groups.

The Football Operation Manager will confirm your inclusion in a team and allocation of your guernsey number.

Players must:

- Complete the player registration and pay the \$100 deposit on PlayHQ using the link below. https://www.playhq.com/afl/register/fbbd0a
- Ensure you have the latest compulsory South Australian AFL Masters apparel.
- All apparel is purchased through our state uniform supplier Worklocker via the link below, payment is required at time of ordering. https://worklockeradelaidecity.com.au/collections/sa-afl-masters/AFL-MASTERS
- Ensure you order the correct size. Samples will be available at state training sessions and at the city store to try on for sizing.
- Participants are to arrange their own transport to and from ovals during the carnival. (free shuttle busses will be available)
- Have fun and enjoy the spirit of the AFL Masters Carnival.

Your Guernsey and Number

If you played in the previous year's national carnival, you may be able to use your existing number except if you are changing grades (divisions) or age groups and the number is already allocated in the grade/age group you are moving to. In this instance it is your responsibility to agree to a new number with the Football Operations Manager.

The women's representatives will provide guernsey numbers to the women players.

If a previous carnival player already has been allocated a guernsey number in the same age group, the player who was assigned the number at previous carnivals will have priority to use that number if in the same age group.

e.g If a player attended a National Carnival 3 years ago in the 35's but did not attend the previous carnival, this player has the first option to their guernsey number if in the same age group.

How to make payment for registration only

Your \$100 deposit must be paid via Playhq at the time of registering. (transaction fees apply)
